SOME INFORMATION ABOUT OUR PARKS



Rarau – Natural reservation park

It is situated in Suceava in Romania, Pietrele Doamnei (Lady's Rocks), known under this name are some of the most interesting geological forms in Rarau Mountains in the Carpathians.

The Natural Reserve Pietrele
Doamnei was declared a protected
area in 2000. Here you can also
find plants like edelweiss or
Venus's slipper, plants protected by
law. One legend says that the rock
was split into two by a lightning
sent by the devil that wanted to
find the treasure hidden by a king,
but it failed.



Anglia park

It is situated in Komarno in Slovakia, Anglia Park served as a place for relaxation and entertainment for the citizens of Komárno and its numerous military garrison during the 19th century. A band-stand, which once stood here, witnessed concerts of a military band whose bandleader was Franz Lehár Senior. Nowadays, the stand's copy can be found on the Europe Square. A statue of the Ungarian and Czech king, Ladislaus the Posthumous is displayed as a reminder of his birth to Emperor Albert II and Elizabeth of Luxembourg (he was born 4 months after his father's death) which took place in the Komárno fortress in 1440. He died at the age of 17 in Prague most likely due to leukemia despite rumors that he was poisoned.



San Rossore park

Park Migliarino San Rossore Massaciuccoli stretches along the coast of the provinces of Pisa and Lucca, in an area that was once characterized by lagoons and marshes.

Over time the area was filled with sediment carried by the rivers Serchio and Arno and by the Tyrrhenian Sea. But the territory is also the result of the work of man, who has channelled the waterways and reclaimed the land over the centuries. Reclamation commenced during the rule of the Medici.
